When adopted, the Plan will also amend The General Plan (On Wedges and Corridors) for the Physical Development of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Montgomery and Prince George's Counties.

This Plan makes recommendations for land use and zoning within the Germantown Plan for the Town Sector Zone Master Plan area for approximately 1,429 acres primarily consisting of properties in the Churchill Village section of Germantown that are zoned Town Sector, including Lake Churchill and part of Little Seneca Lake. The plan is generally bounded by Little Seneca Lake to the northwest, Crystal Rock Drive to the northeast, Locbury Drive to the southeast and Father Hurley Boulevard and the CSX railroad tracks to the south.
