Zoning Strategies

- ZTA to allow house-scale 'infill' attainable housing in residential zones
- ZTA to establish a new optional method of development for larger scale projects near transit • and along corridors
- Master Plan Process to identify areas for potential rezoning

Subdivision Strategies

Minor subdivisions for infill attainable housing

Regulatory Strategies

Ongoing coordination with other regulatory agencies (stormwater, fire and rescue, DOT, DPS)
