- **Environmental impact/Tree loss concerns**

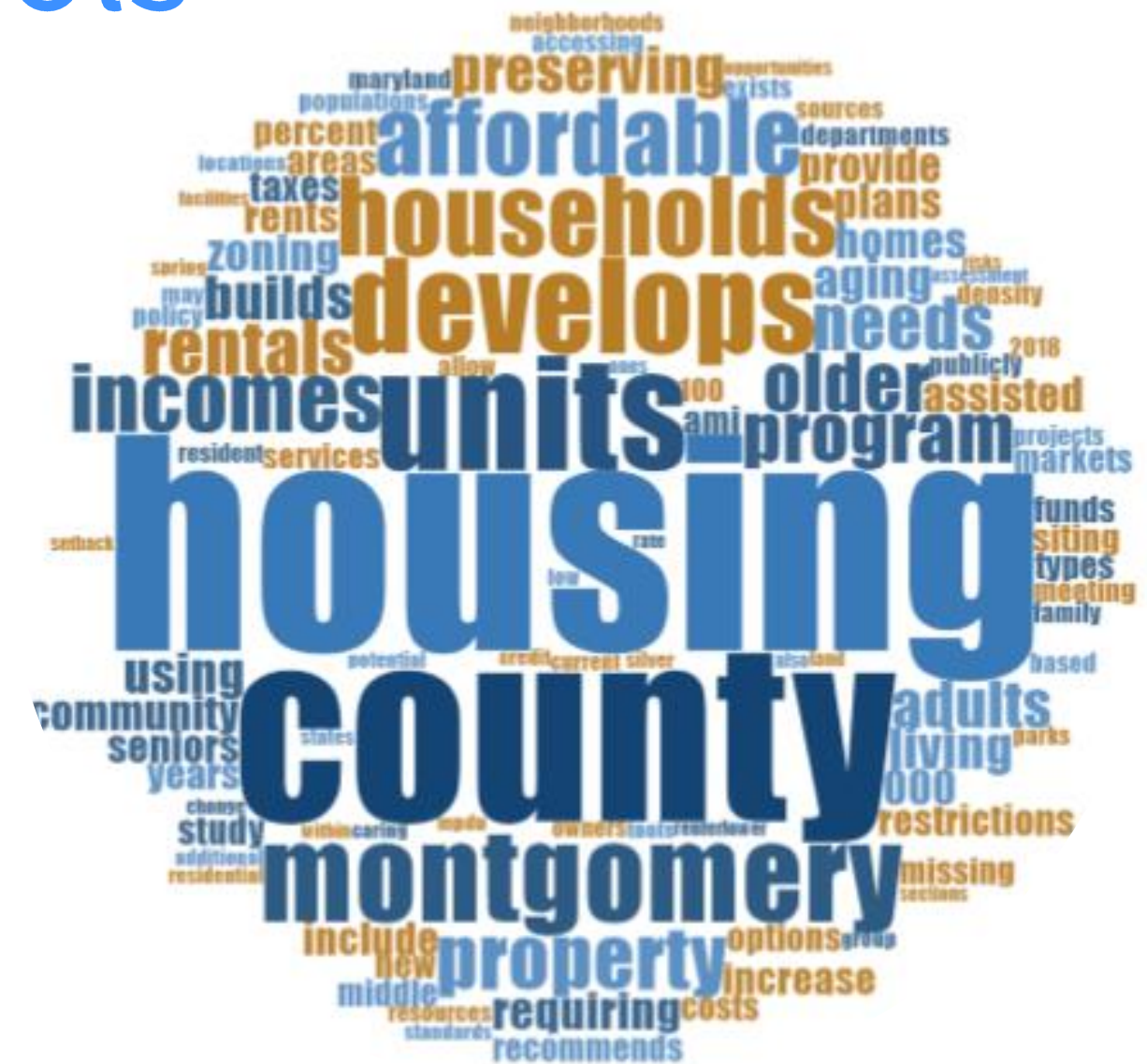

Regulations as a Tool for Attainability

Zoning Strategies

- ZTA to allow house-scale ‘infill’ attainable housing in residential zones
- ZTA to establish a new optional method of development for larger scale projects near transit and along corridors
- Master Plan Process to identify areas for potential rezoning

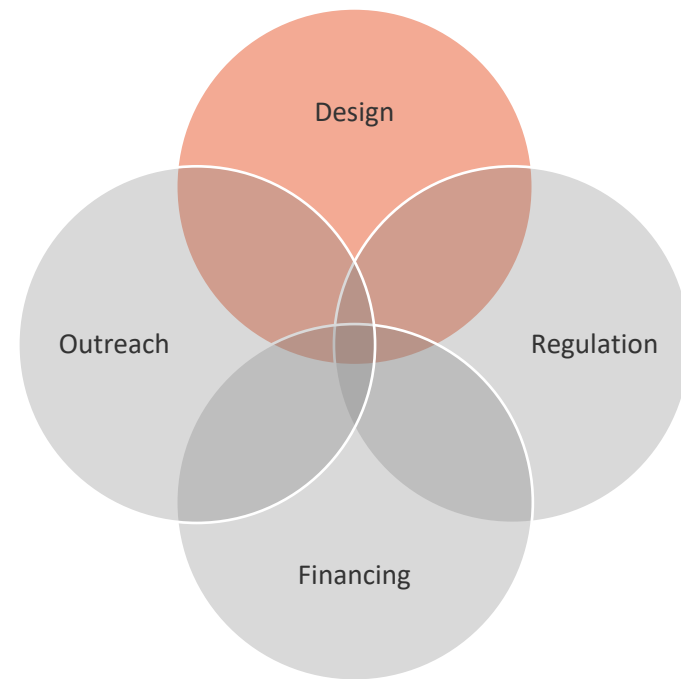
Subdivision Strategies

- Minor subdivisions for infill attainable housing

Regulatory Strategies

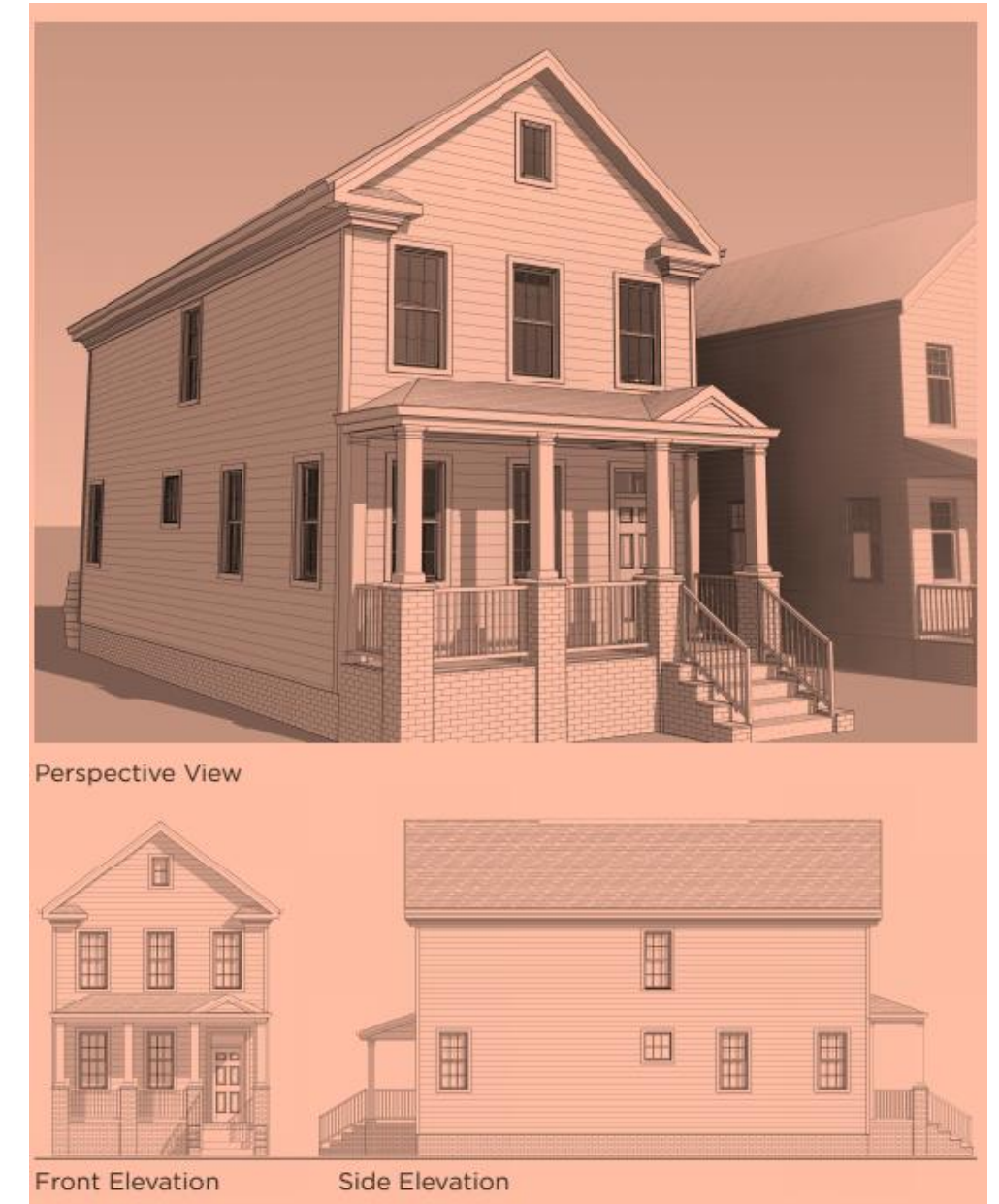
- Ongoing coordination with other regulatory agencies (stormwater, fire and rescue, DOT, DPS)
