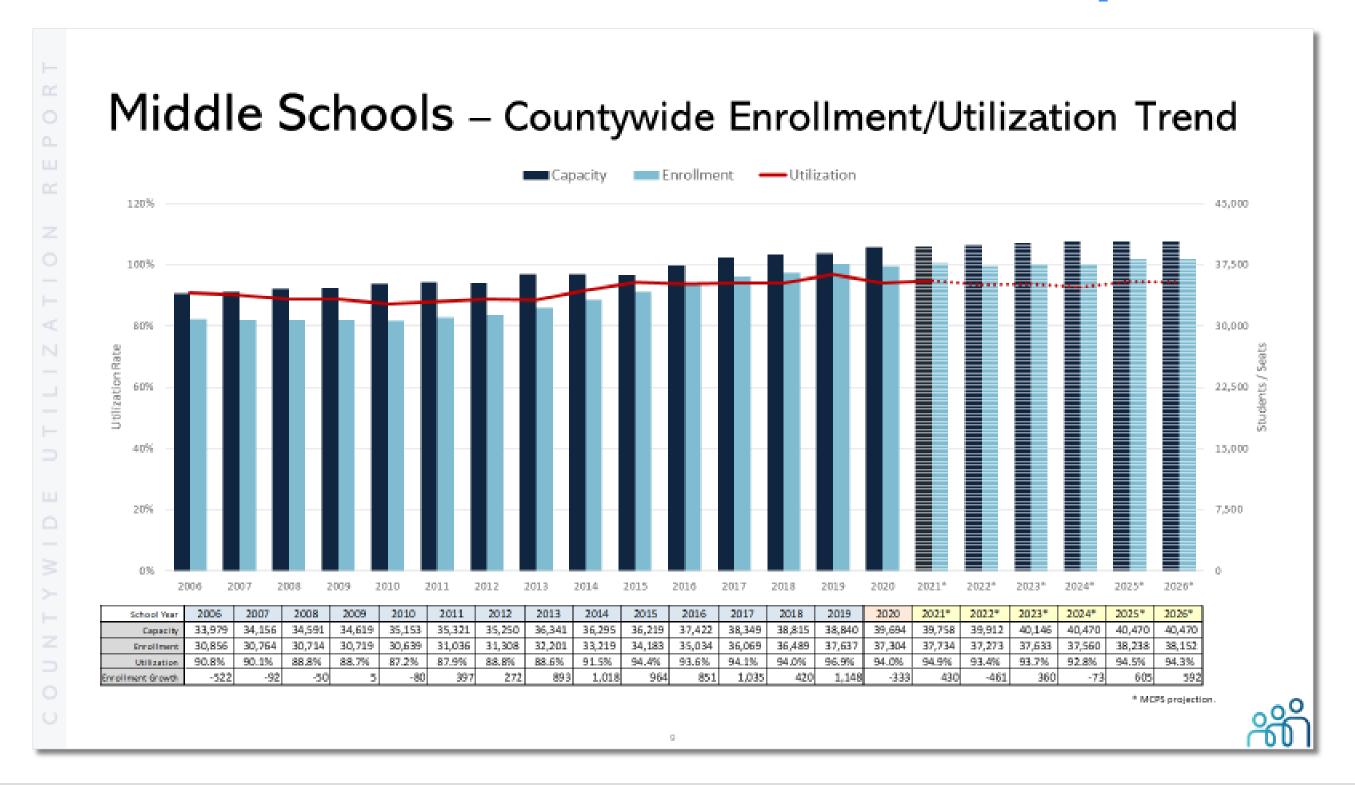


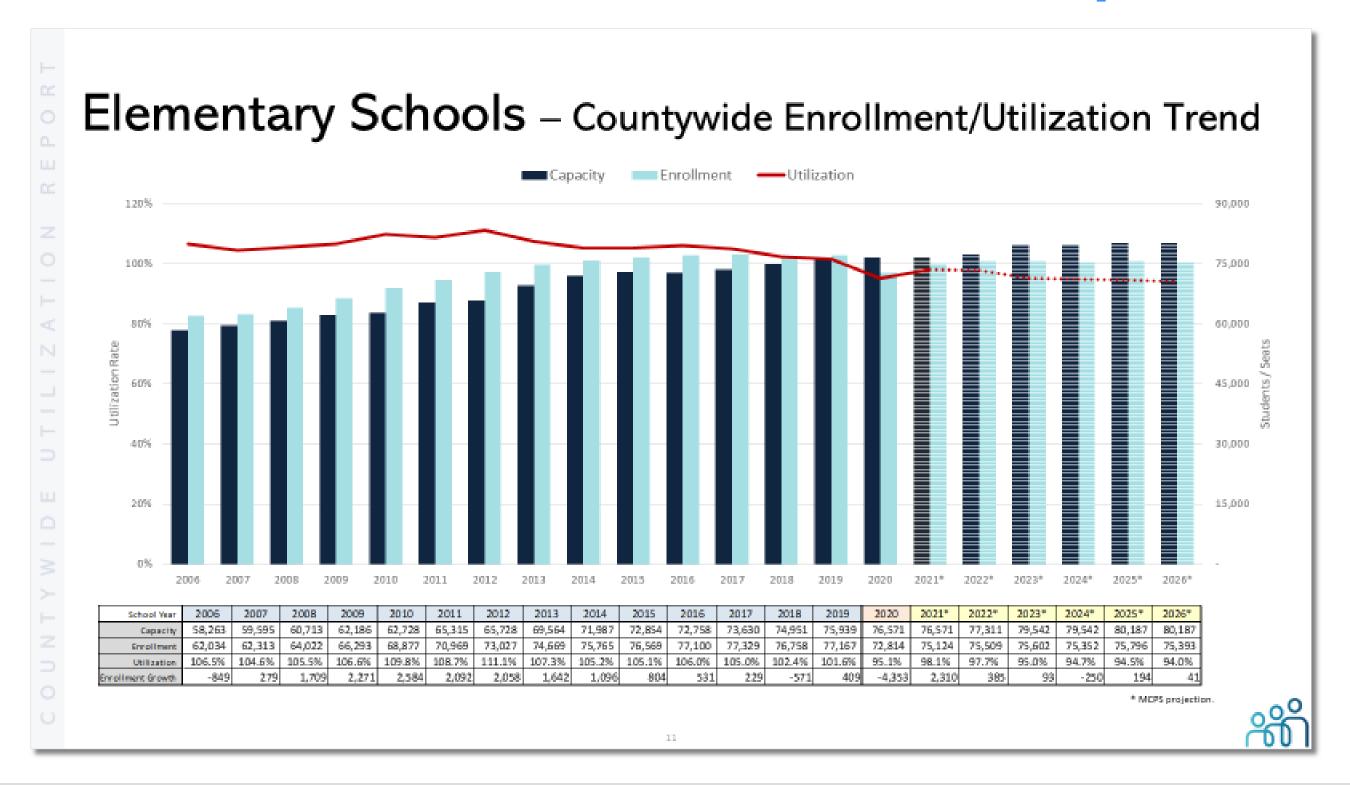
FY 2022 AST – Total UPP Rates

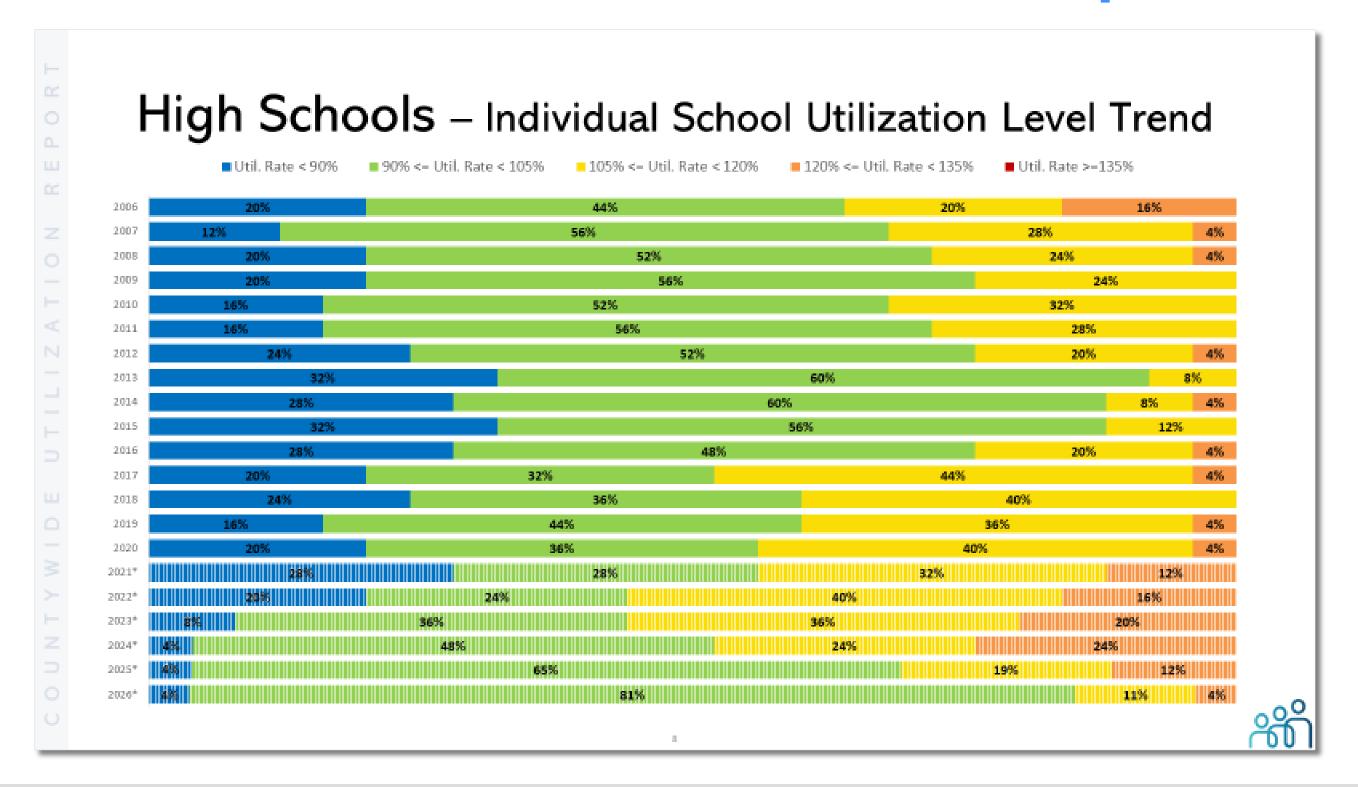


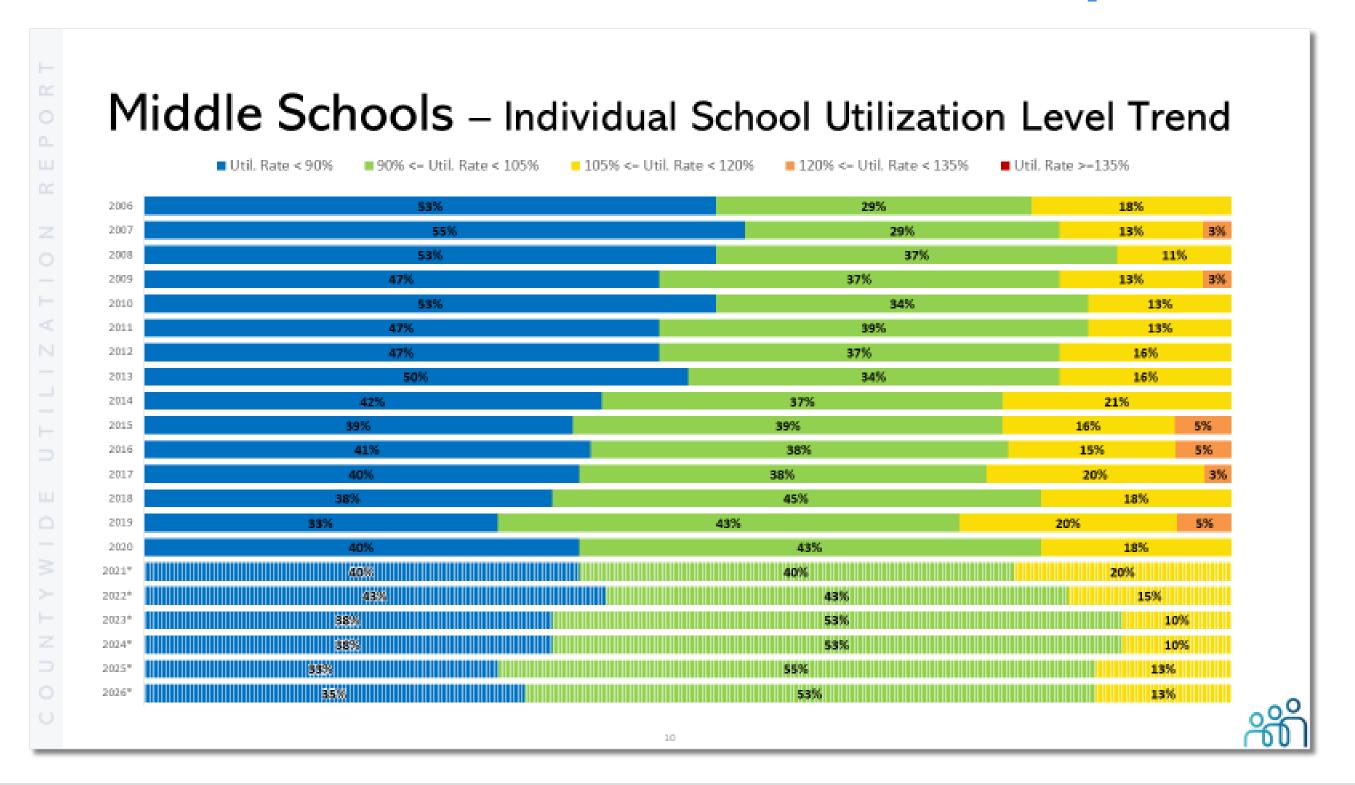




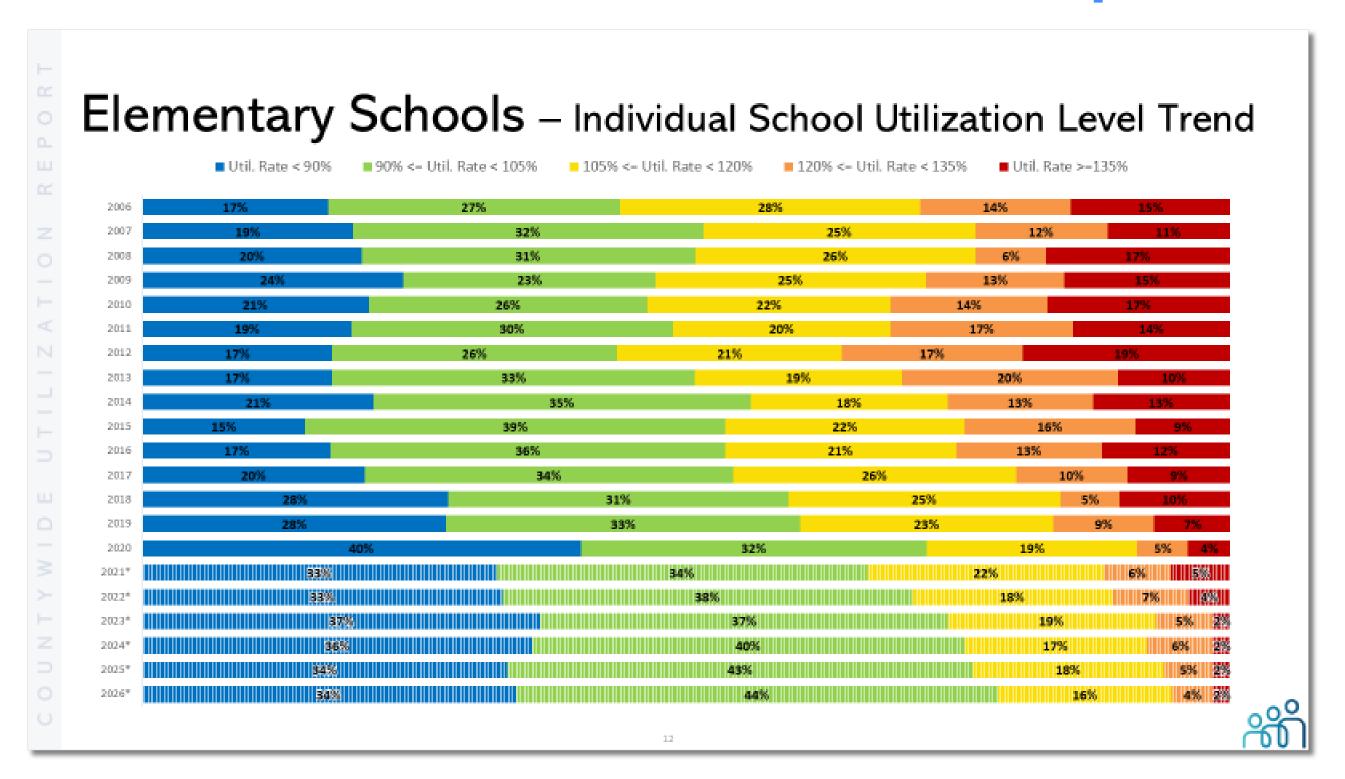




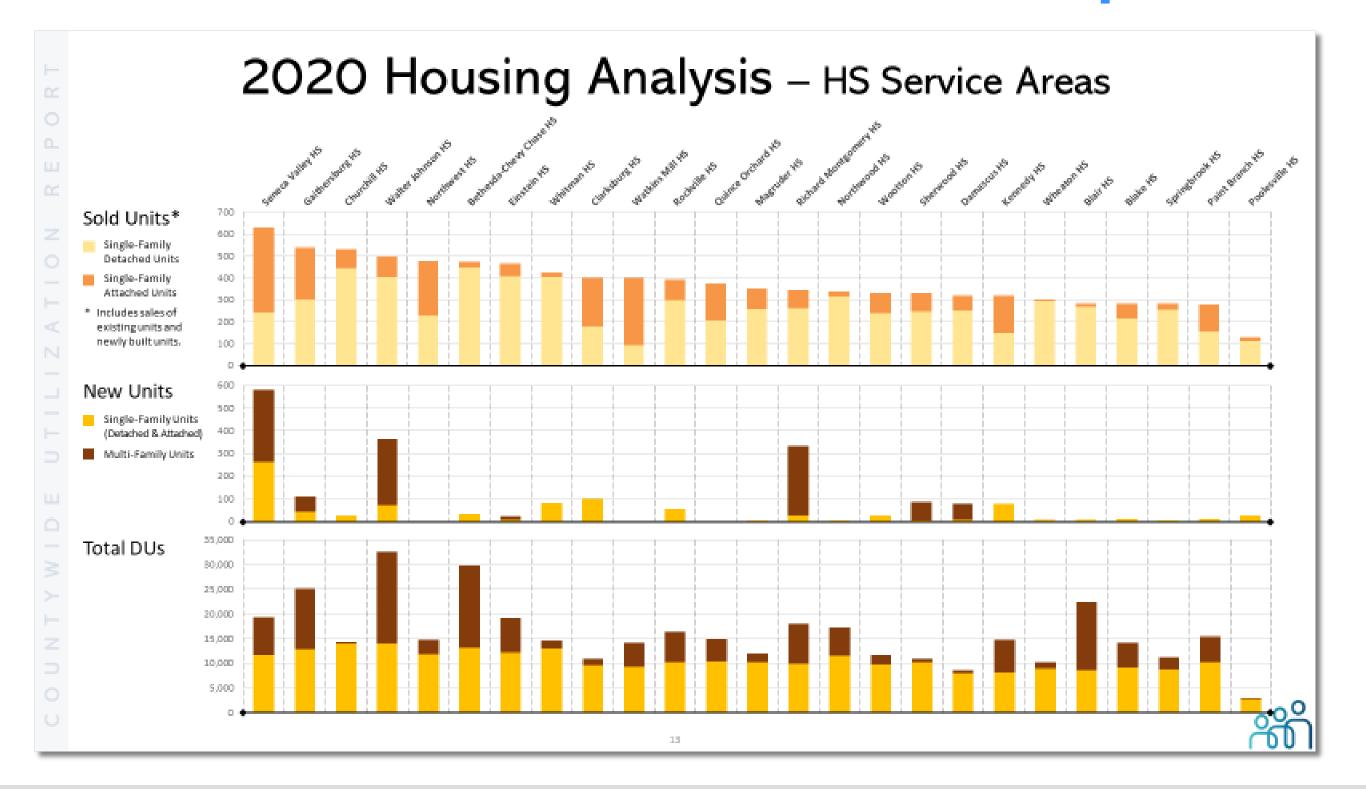
