Demographic Profile of Council Districts

Montgomery County, MD (2022)

This report provides demographic information for the newly drawn seven Montgomery County Council Districts and the County overall from the 2016-2020 American Community Survey, 5-Year estimates¹. The Montgomery County Charter requires the Council Districts be compact, contiguous and substantially equal in population. Boundaries for Council Districts are redrawn every 10 years by a special Commission on Redistricting composed of residents appointed by the County Council with mixed political affiliations. In 2021, the Commission also had the task of creating boundaries for two new districts as a result of a 2020 referendum that increased the number of districts from five to seven.

In addition to creating districts that are nearly equal in population, the Commission sought to ensure meaningful representation of racial and ethnic groups, with a particular focus on creating a district that is majority people of color in the eastern part of the county. The Commission also sought to avoid splitting neighborhoods. The new Council districts were formally adopted by the County Council in December 2021 for the 2022 general election.

Population Density

As required by statute, the seven districts are similar in total population. However, they differ in land area and population density. District 2, in the northwestern part of the county, has the lowest population density with 818 people per square mile, as well as the largest area (187 square miles). In contrast, District 4, containing Silver Spring and North Bethesda, has the smallest land area (20 square miles) and highest population density (7,015 people per square mile.)

Households and Families

The districts range in average household size from 2.4 to 3.1 and in presence of children from 27.0% to 39.3%. District 2 had the lowest proportion of residents over 65 (11%), and District 1 had the highest (20.6%). Nearly 66% of Montgomery County households are owner-occupied. Greater than three quarters of residents live in owner-occupied homes in Districts 1,2, and 7. Renters are a majority only in District 4.

Racial and Ethnic Composition

The Montgomery County population is majority people of color with 56.9% of residents identifying as Hispanic or non-white. District 1 is the only district where any one racial or ethnic group is a majority of the population--68.7% of residents are White. District 2 has the highest proportion of Asian residents (24.3%) and is the county's most diverse district.² District 6 has the highest proportion of Hispanic

² Diversity is measured using the Simpson-Gini index, which calculates the chance that two randomly selected people will belong to the same racial or ethnic group.




¹ The boundaries of Census block groups and council districts do not perfectly overlap, so for the purposes of this report, block groups were assigned to the council district containing most of a block group's land area. This method produced a 99% correspondence between block groups and council districts.

residents (35.2%). The highest percentage of Black residents is in District 5 (37.7%).

Income and Education

Average income for Montgomery County is \$152,779. Districts 2-7 all have average incomes between \$116,000 and \$144,595. District 1's average income is \$265,145, 80% higher than the next-highest district. District 1 also has the highest percentage of residents with at least a bachelor's degree—85.7%, compared with a county average of 59.2%.
