



Community 'Gap' Analysis

Transportation

- Good regional highway connectivity brings traffic that creates an unfriendly pedestrian environment.
- Poor internal connectivity, insufficient transit service and lack of amenities contribute to the high vehicle dependency

Economic Health

- Community food insecurity and lack of diverse retail options may be the result of commercial space dominated by offices and higher rents; revitalization needed for some commercial space.
- Local job opportunities are not for the local talents; housing for local employees, training for local talent/resident, and **more** competitive jobs with higher pay.














Community 'Gap' Analysis

Crime Prevention


- **Moderate crime**, except for Briggs Chaney Marketplace.
- Lacks community programs and design of public and private open spaces, leads to **negative perceptions for public safety**.
- Lacks social cohesion, poor property maintenance, and public open space can result in incidents of disorderly conduct.
- Incidents of disorderly conduct and actual crime can worsen the perception for public safety and discourage civic life.
- Other socioeconomic factors include lack of social assistance programs and land use patterns (single-use, commercially-zoned blocks).




Total Crime Incidents Map (Source: CrimeGrade.org)


Not Working


