

Farms and Size of Farms




After declining from 2002 to 2012, the number of farms in Montgomery County increased from 2012 to 2022, with **583 total farm operations** in 2022.

Montgomery County gained large (over 1,000 acres) and small (under 50 acres) farms but lost midsized farms. This trend aligns with national trends.




Median Size of Farms in Maryland and Suburban Virginia Counties in 2022




