


GETTING STARTED

- Once your account is setup, you'll be able to log in and access the full Community Planning Academy course and its accompanying resources.




THE LEARNER DASHBOARD

ACCESSING THE COURSE


Click the tile labeled "**My Course**" to access the course homepage. The course homepage will show each of the required activities and modules.

When new modules are added, they will appear on this course homepage.




ACCESSING THE COURSE

You'll need to complete each prerequisite module or activity before moving to the next.


The first activity is the **Pre-Course Evaluation Survey**.

To begin or continue a module, click the **Start** button next to it.




THE COURSE PLAYER

You can further adjust your course player view by selecting one of the view options in the top right corner.






COURSE PLAYER NAVIGATION

Use the course player to navigate the material:


- Use the play/pause button to start/stop the content.
- Make the content full screen by clicking the expand icon to the left of the previous button.
- Click "Next" to advance to the next section.
- Click "Previous" to return to the previous section.
- Need to review a previous section? Click the header in the left-hand menu to jump back to that section.



COURSE PLAYER NAVIGATION


- Adjust the voiceover volume by clicking the speaker icon.
- To rewind within the section you are currently viewing, slide the timer bar until your reach the desired placement.

To get the most out of the experience, please view each slide in full and in the intended order—fast-forwarding is disabled.




LEARNING CHECK

Each module will end with a short learning check questionnaire designed to help you review key concepts. These checks are not graded, and there is no pass or fail for the course.




RESOURCE LIBRARY


We encourage you to browse, download, and bookmark any resources that interest you. The syllabus and module study guides are also available here.







Each study guide can also be accessed and downloaded through the "**Resources**" tab within the course player.




PLANNING GLOSSARY

Throughout the course, you'll encounter many planning terms—many of which may be new to you. You can access the full **Planning Glossary** from your dashboard at any time.




PLANNING GLOSSARY

INBOX AND COURSE COMMUNICATION


